The ESDC secretariat provided information on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Essay Writing Competition and the amended **Regulation for the CSDP Writing Competition for EUMSSF for 2022**.

#### 7) International activities including Summer Schools: state of play

The Chair asked Forum members to provide information on summer schools open to participants from other schools. The Italian Naval Military School "Francesco MOROSINI" presented the 2<sup>nd</sup> International Venetian Rowing Course taking place in Venezia (Italy) from 11 to 16 July.

The Forum agreed to hold the **next (10th) meeting** of the Forum in person on 6 September 2022 in Brussels (Sars-CoV-2 allowing).
