



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

COMMON MODULE: AVIATION ENGLISH PART 1

9th - 20th December 2024

1. Participants

This Common Module is mainly directed to cadets and young officers with the English level B1 according to CEFR or NATO STANAG Level 2 and are interested in expanding their English skills, focusing on the aviation language. We can accept up to 12 participants, 2 participants per institution. First come - first served rule applies.

2. Travel arrangements

2.1. Arrival

Participants are asked to arrive to Dęblin train station on 9th September 2024. There will pick-up arranged for all participants arriving by train to Dęblin. Participants arriving by car are asked to arrive at PAFU premises on 9th September 2024 as well. Please be advised that there will be no possibility use the car at the PAFU military premises - since it should be parked at the hotel parking spot for the duration of the module.

2.2. Departure

Participants are asked to depart from PAFU on 20th September 2024. The drop-off will be arranged to transport participants to train station in Dęblin accordingly.

3. Accommodation

All participants will be accommodated in the hotel at the PAFU premises with no fee.

4. Meals

Meals will be provided to all participants with no fee at the PAFU Student's Canteen (breakfast, lunch, dinner).

5. Dress code

Combat uniforms are to be worn during classes. For cultural events, civilian clothes are required. Official military dress service uniform is required for the official opening and closing of the module. Sports clothes will be required to attend sports activities.

6. Access to PAFU premises

All participants will receive temporary guest passes which are necessary in order to enter and leave the PAFU military premises, where the classes will be held. There is no pass needed to enter the hotel.

It is recommended for participants of the module to bring a personal laptop or tablet to conduct internet research and self-study during the module.
